Bibliographic History	<p>Born in Dublin in 1952, Derek Speirs worked in a photo-finishing laboratory when he left school and later studied in London, where he graduated from the Polytechnic of Central London and the Royal College of Art in 1977. He then worked as a photographer in London, with the Report Agency and its founder Simon Guttman. Derek Speirs is a working photojournalist, whose images are used constantly in the press in Ireland and abroad. His photographs are the products of a clear decision which Derek made early in his practice about the kind of photographer he could be as a result of his understanding of the medium and its context.</p> <p>Over the past forty years a variety of independent local and regional Traveller initiatives and national Traveller organisations have used community work approaches and methods in their work for justice, equality and human rights with Travellers. Derek has worked with Travellers for the last forty years ones of the biggest successes was achieving the government to acknowledge the ethnicity of Travellers in 2017 that was a big occasion.</p>

Scope and Content	<p>This collection contains photographs related to Travellers, Roma and at Pavee Point events that were taken by Derek Speirs throughout his career and is divided into thirteen series. The first series which comprises photographs of Traveller accommodation is the oldest and largest of the collection. The second series features photographs of Traveller children and young people. The third series contains photographs of events and displays of Traveller culture and features Traveller Focus Week and Culture Night. The fourth series features photographs of discrimination against Travellers, marches and protests, conferences and press events related to Traveller rights and the recognition of Traveller ethnicity. The fifth series features photographs of Travellers engaging with economic activities. The sixth series consists of photographs of Travellers in education from early years education to post secondary. The seventh series consists of photographs taken at events and conferences in relation to Pavee Point Health Programmes. The eighth series featured photographs of Traveller men and the ninth series consists of photographs of Pavee Point people and Pavee Point early days. The tenth series consists of photographs of religious practices and the eleventh series consists of photographs of Roma families, Roma celebrations and events including Genocide Remembrance. The twelfth series consists of photographs of events related to solidarity and community development and the thirteenth series consists of photographs of Traveller women and events about Traveller women.</p>
System of Arrangement	<p>The decision was made to arrange the physical and digital material together, especially as there were many digital copies of physical photographs. A copy and a digital image of the CDs of Derek Speirs' photographs was created to also maintain the original order. The current arrangement series was based upon the chapters of the book '30 years of Pavee Point' which was published to celebrate the 30th anniversary of Pavee Point. Many of the details within the descriptions of the photographs in this collection are based upon the captions that were written on the back of the photographs or featured within the detailed metadata written by Derek Speirs. Although a reference code was created an effort was made to also list the original code made by Derek Speirs when possible as this code corresponds to his current system of arrangement. The physical photographs have unique references written on the back while the digital files are referenced as follows: source, date, location, unique reference, file extension.</p>

Archival History	The remains of two separate, partial systems of arrangement existed with the prints and a small number of the colour prints. These photographs had been organised in a mostly chronological order and were mixed in with photographs that were taken by other photographers and copies of photographs from other archives. In order to create this collection Derek's photographs were separated from these other photographs. The rest of the colour print were discovered in a clear out of the office. These colour prints had not been arranged and only small parts of the original order remained. The vast majority of digital files were stored in numbered CDs, some of which were not related to Derek Speirs. Some other files had previously been WeTransferred from Derek Speirs to Pavee Point.
Condition	The photographs are in good condition with a few colour prints having minor discolouration and small tears on a few of the large prints.
